GUEST RULES

Eligible members (an eligible member is one who is 18 years or older and who has paid all his/her dues and fees) may invite guests to enjoy the facilities of the Quarry Swimming Association subject to the following conditions:

1. The eligible member **must be present with the guests and the guests must leave when the member leaves.**

2. The eligible member must see that his guests:

- a. Conduct themselves in a proper and safe manner.
- **b.** Observe all ground rules and safety rules.
- c. Obey all instructions of the Pool Manager and/or Lifeguard on duty.
- d. Are advised by the member that the guests swimming in the pool, diving, or otherwise using the facilities of the Quarry Swimming Association do so at their own risk (as do members), and that neither the Quarry Swimming Association, nor any of the Officers of the Quarry Swimming Association, shall be held responsible for any injury occurring to any guest or member while the guest or member is using the facilities of the Association.

3. Any person may not be accorded guest privileges on **more than six occasions in any one calendar year**, regardless of the different members who may invite the person, except in cases covered elsewhere in these rules.

4. In the case of houseguests, the Committee of Admissions and Membership shall, upon request of the host, make equitable provision for the accommodation of such guests. The Committee of Admissions and Membership shall notify the Pool Manager of the guest privileges awarded prior to the admission of the guest. Houseguests do not have to be accompanied by the member unless they are under 12 years.

5. The guests' names and the accompanying eligible member's name shall be registered with the life guard on duty prior to the guest using the facilities.

6. No eligible member may bring **more than six guests** to the pool at one time, except that an eligible member wishing to entertain a large group of guests (up to 16) at the Quarry at one time may do so only if:

- a. The member makes arrangements for the affair with the Pool Manager at least seven days in advance.
- b. The member must pay the required guests' fee and register them individually with the lifeguard.

7. Although the Association does not encourage members entertaining large groups, those wishing to bring more than 16 guests to the Quarry at one time must petition the Board of Directors at least two weeks in advance. The member must hire an extra guard for the period of the party from one of the regular certified complement who will not be on regular Quarry life guarding duty during the affair.

8. In a household unit where there is a certificate holder or spouse who has paid his dues and fees for the current season and where there is a long-term temporary member of the unit residing (i.e. longer than two months, such as a foreign exchange student), the Committee of Admissions and Membership will consider the awarding of some equitable arrangement for guest privileges upon petition of the host.
